

## Antipoverty Fund

### **Purpose**

Antipoverty Funds are for domestic poverty alleviation.

### **Description**

Antipoverty Funds are provided to Saskatchewan Synod from the partnership of The Evangelical Lutheran Church in Canada (ELCIC) and [Canadian Lutheran World Relief \(CLWR\)](#). While the ELCIC and CLWR work in partnership to foster sustainable development in communities globally, the partnership also supports Compassionate Justice Initiatives in Canada. When an undesignated gift is made to CLWR, a portion of the donation is directed to support Compassionate Justice initiatives. This funding is allotted annually to Synods who adjudicate applications from congregations and ministries.

### **Criteria**

The following are the priorities for assessing Antipoverty applications:

1. The project builds awareness of hunger and poverty issues as well as solutions through education, leadership development and advocacy.
2. The project focuses on domestic hunger and poverty issues with priority given to:
  - a. Food security (i.e. production, distribution, acquisition, nutrition, land use);
  - b. Employment (i.e. job training, counselling, placement, childcare);
  - c. Development (i.e. preventative and primary health care, water and sanitation, literacy, housing, social services, environmental issues).
3. The project is planned in cooperation with and builds on the social, cultural and spiritual resources of people who have access to limited material resources.
4. The project promotes self-reliance.
5. The project operates in collaboration with other ecumenical and social services partners.

Applications must be received at Synod office by May 1 each year.
